Scheme of Work for Spanish



Year 6 Autumn Term: Weather, seasons, expressions of frequency, geography of Spain, compass points, settlements, places in town, describing a photo, Christmas

About this unit: Pupils will learn to talk about the weather and describe the weather in different seasons. They will learn about the geography of Spain and use points of the compass to describe where towns, cities and regions are in Spain and where they live. They will then combine this knowledge to describe a photo of different settlements. Pupils will end the term by increasing their awareness of how Christmas is celebrated in Spanish-speaking countries.
