Curriculum Overview

What we are learning about in **Year 4** during **Half Term 1**



In Maths we will be learning:

- representing numbers and the number line to 1000
- finding 1, 10, 100, 1000 more and less
 - counting in 1000s
 - partitioning number up to 1000
- rounding to the nearest 10, 100, 1000
- order and compare numbers
 - negative numbers
 - roman numerals to 100
- adding and subtracting 1, 10s, 100s and 1000s
- adding and subtracting up to 4 digit numbers



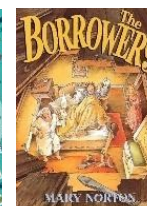
Our book for this half term in English, which our writing will be focused around is

Todd-Stanton. Over the term we will be producing a persuasive letter and writing a narrative where we will plan, draft and produce our own ending to the story.



Our books for this half term in Reading Skills will be **Matilda**, **Planet Omar** and **The Borrowers**. The skills we will focus on are **vocabulary, inference, prediction, explanation, retrieval and sequencing.**



Our Science topic for this half term will be **Electricity**

In this topic we will learn...

- How we use electricity?
- How electricity flows and what materials it will flow through?
- How to stay safe around electricity?
- Is electricity always the same?

The scientific skills we will cover are: **asking questions, making predictions, observing and measuring, recording, interpreting and communicating data**



Our focus in RE this half term will be thinking about what does it mean to be a Christian in Britain today.



In computing we will be focusing on learning about what the internet is and if we can believe everything we see online.

Our focus in Spanish will be learning key classroom language and basic greetings, numbers to 31, months of the year and seasons.



Wider Curriculum



In History we will be looking into the impact the Roman Empire has had on Britain and if things we do and have today are a direct result of a successful Roman invasion.



In RSHE we will be looking at the themes of community and relationships and learning about bias, echo chambers, stereotypes and accepting our friends for who they are.

Design & Technology
