What we are learning about in Year 1 during Half Term 2



- In Maths we will be learning to....
- Subtraction two numbers (within 10)
 - Recognise 3D shapes
 - Count forwards and backwards to 20
 - Read and write numbers to 20
 - Count one more/one less to 20
 - Use the < > and = symbols
 - Understand tens and ones

In phonics this half term we will be focusing on phase 5 digraphs and . Children will also learn how to pronounce alternative graphemes or sounds that they already know e.g ai as in rain and ay as in play. Please see the phonics page on the school website for a glossary of terms.



Our Science topic for this half term will be **Identifying Animals.** In this topic we will learn...

- What makes animals different
- How to group animals like scientists
- Why animals belong in those groups
- What animals eat and how they eat it

Wider Curriculum



In Geography we are looking at where we live, things that are natural/man-made around us and we will begin to understand how we use a map.



In Computing we are looking at what tools are used for digital painting before having a go at using these to create our own.



We are going to be looking at an artist called Henri Rousseau. We are going to create a jungle inspired collage.



In music we will be using our bodies and instruments to respond to classical music that represents animals.



In DT we are going to be looking at free standing structures and what they are used for.



In History we are going to be looking at Remembrance day and understanding why people wear poppies.
