

## Curriculum Overview

What we are learning about in **Year 4** during **Half Term 2**



### In Maths we will be learning:

- fractions (tenths, common equivalent, fractions of quantities, fractions to divide quantities, counting in fractions, fractions greater than one)
- measurement (equivalent lengths cm—m, mm—cm, kilometre—metre, adding and subtracting lengths, perimeter on a grid and rectangle, area and perimeter of rectilinear shapes by counting squares)
- Multiplication & division (divide by 10, 100, 100, factor pairs, multiply 3 digit by 2 digit number, divide 2 digit by 1 digit)



Our book for this half term in English, which our writing will be focused around is **Empire's End** by Leila Rasheed. Over the term we will be producing an explanation to inform and creating a playscript linked to the events in the story.



Our books for this half term in Reading Skills will be **The Accidental Prime Minister, The Accidental Diary of a B.U.G and Did the Romans Eat Chips**. The skills we will focus on are **vocabulary, inference, prediction, explanation, retrieval and sequencing.**



Our Science topic for this half term will be **classification**

In this topic we will learn...

- What habitats are in the school ground?
- Can you make keys?
- What are vertebrates and invertebrates?
- What groups do plants have?
- Can habitats change?
- How do humans change habitats?

The scientific skills we will cover are: **asking questions, making predictions, observing and measuring, recording, interpreting and communicating data**



Our focus in RE this half term will be thinking about why do some people think that life is a journey? What significant experiences mark this?



In computing we will be focusing on learning about how sounds can be digitally recorded.

Our focus in Spanish will be learning about birthdays and Christmas

In Geography we will be looking at what makes Europe famous by looking at the locational geography of Europe, including looking at the countries that make it up, physical and human features as
