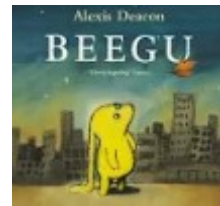


In Maths we will be learning to....

- Compare length and height
- Measure in non standard units and cm
- Add and subtract to 20, including number bonds and doubles
- Introduce and compare weight and mass
- Introduce and compare capacity and volume

phonics

In phonics this half term we will be focusing on phase 5 digraphs and . Children will also learn how to pronounce alternative graphemes or sounds that they already know e.g ai as in rain and ay as in play. Please see the phonics page on the school website for a glossary of terms.



Our Science topic for this half term will be **Human body and senses**. In this topic we will learn...

- What all the body parts are called
- How to use our body to find things out
- If things taste the same when they are hot, cold or warm
- If our skin senses the same in different parts of the body
- How good our touch is
- How Louis Braille used his sense of touch

In Computing we are looking at digital writing. We are going to explore the keyboard and be able to add and remove text as well as making changes to these. E.g. size and font



In RE we will be looking at how we should care for others in the world and why it is important to do so.



This half term we are looking at sculpture. We will look at a variety of artists that use different materials to make their sculptures. Then we will look at paper mache and use this to create our own animal sculptures.
