

Curriculum Overview

What we are learning about in Year 4 during Half Term 3



In Maths we will be learning:

Roman Numerals - (Solve number and practical problems)

- Shape (Identify the properties of 2D and 3D shapes, Identify angles, Compare and order angles)

- Multiplication & division (divide by 10, 100, 100, factor pairs, multiply 3 digit by 2 digit number, divide 2 digit by 1 digit)

Addition and subtraction - (add two 4 digit numbers – more than one exchange Subtract two 4 digit numbers – more than one exchange)



Our book for this half term in English, which our 🕻 writing will be focused around is The Explorer by Katherine Rundell. RUNDELL Over the tern we will be producing instructions and a

journal linked to the events in the story.



Our books for this half term in Reading Skills will be Front Desk, Goodnight Mr Tom and Tom's Midnight Garden. The skills we will focus on are vocabulary, inference, prediction, explanation, retrieval and sequencing.







In History this half term we will be exploring

Britain's settlement by Anglo-Saxons and Scots and discovering what happened to Britain after the Romans left.

We will research Sutton Hoo and discover what Anglo-Saxon burial places tell us about the Anglo-Saxons



Our focus in RE this half term will be discovering why different festivals are important to religious communities



In computing we will be focusing on learning about how to create a programme using repetition of shape.

Our focus in Spanish will be learning about Shapes, Colours and adjectives to describe.





In Geography we will be looking at different parts of South America and comparing rural and city areas. We will explore why is the Amazon Rainforest so important and what can be done to protect the Rainforest's future.



In RSHE we

will be looking at online safety. We will learn how to recognise ways in which the internet and social media can be used both positively and negatively and how to assess the reliability of sources of information



In Art we will be focusing on sculpture skills. We will be creating a tool inspired by Anglo Saxons and Scots with Mod Roc.

Our focus in PE will be learning skills for gymnastics and orienteering.
