What we are learning about in Year 1 during Half Term 5





In Maths we will be learning to.... -compare number sentences -finding amounts with money (2's,5's and 10's) -Division (arrays) -Fractions 1/4 - Subtraction fact families



Our books for this half term are based on the author Vivian French. We will be looking at Oliver's Vegetables, Oliver's Fruit Salad and Oliver's Milkshake.







In phonics this half term we will be focusing on phase 5 digraphs and . Children will also learn how to pronounce alternative graphemes or sounds that they already know e.g ie as in pie and ie as in shield. Please see the phonics page on the school website for a glossary of terms.



Our Science topic for this half term will be Everyday materials. In this topic we will learn...

- -What the parts of a plant are called -How different are leaves to each other
- -What are the names of trees around us
- -How different are flowers to each other
- -What are the names of small plants around us
- -What is the weirdest plant on the planet

In Computing we are looking at moving a robot. We will have a go at programming a robot to move in different directions and have a go at creating routes to follow a map.



In D&T we are looking at preparing fruit and vegetables. We will investigate and evaluate different fruit and vegetables. Look at how they are prepared and make our own fruit kebab.

In PE we will be developing our skills of ing, catching and fielding with a focus on cricket and athletics.



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In RE we will be looking at who is Jewish and now they live.



In Geography we are looking at 'Where on Earth'. We will be looking at the continents, oceans and physical and human features.



This half term we are looking at portraits. We will have a focus on the eye, looking at different parts of it. Using our new skills we will create a self portrait.



In RSHE we will be looking at what makes a good friend and if friends should tell us what to do.
