What we are learning about in **Year 6** during **Half Term 1**

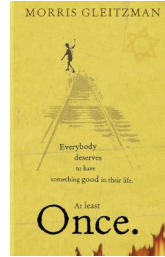


### In Maths we will be learning:

- How to read, write, order and compare numbers to 10 000 000
- Round to any number
  - Roman Numerals
  - Negative numbers
- Add whole numbers and decimals
- Multiply 3-digit and 4-digits by 1-digit and 2-digit numbers
- Divide 4-digits by 1-digit and 2-digit numbers using remainders
- Multi-step problems
- Common Factors, Prime Numbers
- square and cube numbers

## ENGLISH

Our book for this half term in English will be **Once by Morris Gleitzman**. We will be producing a formal letter from Felix to his parents and also a discussion text based on- 'Should Felix' parents have placed him in an orphanage?' We will also produce one more independent piece.



Our books for this half term in Reading Skills will be **When Secrets Set Sail**. We will also look at some branching our texts based around the same theme. The skills we will focus on are **vocabulary, inference, prediction, explanation, retrieval and sequencing**.



## Science

Our Science topic for this half term will be **Healthy Humans**. In this topic we will learn...  
 -What's inside the human body?  
 -How does the circulatory system work?  
 Have you got a motorway inside you?  
 What does exercise do to your heart?  
 How does lifestyle affect health?  
 Why did the Government ban smoking in public places?  
 The scientific skills we will cover are: **asking questions, observing, recording, interpreting and communicating data**



Our focus in RE this half term will be looking at the topic of Christians and answering the question "What would Jesus do?"



In computing we will be focusing on computer systems and networks. We will also learn about how to communicate responsibly online.

Our focus in Spanish will be: **key classroom language, phonics, the geography of Spain and the weather**



## Wider Curriculum



In History we will be looking at post 1066: World War 2. Pupils will consider the causes of WW2 and be able to draw links to the British Empire and consider how the war affected ordinary people.



In RSHE we will be looking at the themes of community and relationships and learning about bias, echo chambers, stereotypes and accepting our friends for who they are.



Our artist study for this half term will be **Pete Mckee**. Pupils will discuss and appreciate his work and create an inspired piece of artwork. The Art skill we will focus on for this half term will be: **Painting**
