Curriculum Overview

What we are learning about in **Year 2** during **Half Term 1**



In Maths we will be learning:

Place value:

- to count objects to 100
- to read and write numbers in numerals and words
- to understand the place value of tens and ones
- to compare and order numbers and objects.

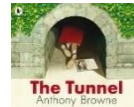
Addition and subtraction:

- adding/subtracting one digit numbers and tens numbers to/from a 2-digit number
- number bonds to 20 and 100

ENGLISH

Our books for this half term are, 'My Shadow is Pink' by Scott Stuart and 'The Tunnel' by Anthony Browne.

We will initially be producing a personal fact-file all about ourselves and then we will be building on this to develop and write a character fact-file.



Science

Our Science topic for this half term will be **Living Things and Habitats**

In this topic we will learn:

- Is it alive?
- Are plants alive? And what is dead?
- What is my habitat?
- What do I need?
- Who eats who?
- Can you link habitats and food chains together?

-Are things the same in other habitats?

The scientific skills we will cover are:

observation, grouping & questioning.



Our focus in RE this half term is Christianity. Pupils will learn about the instructions that Jesus gives in the Bible and how Christians follow his example. Pupils will learn concepts like 'gospel' and good news of forgiveness, peace and love that Christians believe Jesus brings.

Wider Curriculum



In History we will be looking at 'Changes within living memory' by focussing on shopping and identifying similarities and differences between past and present experiences.

Design & Technology

Our DT focus for this half term will be textiles. We will be investigating products, and using what we find out to design our own item which will need to be fit for purpose.



In computing we will be focusing on computing systems and finding out about how they are used on a daily basis in society.
