What we are learning about in **Year 2** during **Half Term 1**



In Maths we will be learning:

Subtraction

- Subtract 1 digit from 2 digit
- Subtract 10 from a 2 digit number
- Missing number problems

Shape

- 2D shape—including lines and vertices
 - lines of symmetry
- 3D shape, count faces, edges and vertices

Money

- pence, pounds, notes and coins
- making amounts

Position and Direction

- movements and turns

Wider Curriculum



In History we will be looking at 'Events beyond living memory' by focussing on the Great Fire of London. Looking at the key people involved and changes to our capital city throughout time.



In Geography we are exploring more about our capital city, linking to the focus of the half term—the Great Fire of London.



In computing we will be focusing digital photography. We will explore how best to take photos and what we can do to make them clear.
