What we are learning about in Year 2 during Summer 1



In Maths we will be learning:

ENGLISH

Our Science topic for this half term will be **Materials**

In this topic we will learn:

The scientific skills we will cover are:

observation, questioning, recording, interpreting and communicating data

In History we will be focusing on Inventors and focusing on the lives of significant individuals.

Our focus in D&T this half term will be mechanisms, looking closely at wheels and axles. In this topic we will cover:
